Introduction

Shirdi Sai Baba (c.1838–1918) is one of India's most universally revered saints, beloved by devotees of all faiths — Hindu, Muslim, and others. He lived a life of simplicity, service, and divine compassion at Shirdi in Maharashtra, and is considered a supreme Sadguru and an incarnation of divine grace.

His two cardinal teachings — Śraddhā (faith) and Ṣabūrī (patience) — form the bedrock of his spiritual philosophy. Baba's message of unity, 'Sab kā mālīk ek' (One God for all), transcends all religious boundaries and continues to inspire millions worldwide.

The Sāibābā Aṣṭottara Śatanāmāvalī contains 108 sacred names drawn from his divine attributes, his role as cosmic teacher, and his boundless compassion. Chanting these names daily is said to bring peace of mind, removal of obstacles, good health, and spiritual upliftment.

How to Use This Booklet: Light a lamp or incense as an offering. Chant 'Om Śrī Sāibābāya Namaḥ' three times to invoke Baba's presence. Then proceed through all 108 names in order, one per bead on a mālā. Close with the Sai Ārtī or a simple prayer of gratitude.
